CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Stanfield City Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Tom McCann at the Stanfield City Council Chambers, located at 150 West Coe Avenue, Stanfield, Oregon.

ROLL CALL

Members present were Mayor Tom McCann and Councilors Pam McSpadden, Lynn Weathermon, Del Manley, and Jack Huxoll. Councilors Don Tyrrell and Jason Sperr were absent. Also present were City Manager Blair Larsen, Public Works Director Scott Morris, Police Chief Bryan Zumwalt, and Finance Director Jerry Carlson.

FLAG SALUTE

Mayor Tom McCann led the audience and members of the Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MARCH 15, 2016

Mayor Tom McCann approved the minutes for the March 15, 2016 council meeting as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police/Court: Chief Zumwalt submitted his report in writing, with no questions from the Council.

Public Works/Building: Mr. Morris said that he received all the bids for the sidewalk grant, and will award it to Roland Wampler. Mr. Larsen said one applicant already paid his portion. Mr. Morris said that they have been working on a sprinkler system at Olympic Park, and will be seeding grass soon. He said there are some water services they need to replace, some sidewalk needs to be fixed by City Hall, and they have begun spraying for weeds on roadsides and alleys. Mayor McCann asked about restriping the bike path on Harding Ave. Mr. Morris said that he needs to find a company that will do it for a reasonable price. He said that the sidewalk at the intersection of Harding and US 395 is a hazard, and needs to be fixed so that it is not at an angle. Mayor asked Jack Bell if the speeding on Harding is a problem. Mr. Bell said that there is a Bronco that speeds through there every morning at 50 mph.

Finance/Administrative: Councilors Manley and McSpadden moved and seconded to pay the bills for the month of March 2016 in the amount of \$124,974.68 as funds become available
Ayes: McSpadden, Weathermon, Manley, and Huxoll. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Safety: None.

Library: None.

Councilors Weathermon and Huxoll moved and seconded to approve all committee reports.
Ayes: McSpadden, Weathermon, Manley, and Huxoll. Nays: None. Motion carried.

COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE

Mr. Jack Bell said that there is a problem near his house, because at nightfall, people turn out their big dogs which harass his little dogs and leave messes. He said there is a blonde colored lab, and a red one. He said he is tired of cleaning up after them. Mr. Larsen asked if he knew what address they were coming from. He did not know. Mr. Bell also asked about the four wheeler ordinance, whether it restricted crossing US 395. Chief Zumwalt said that you can cross US 395 but not travel on US 395, and you must be 16 and have a license. Passenger kids need to have helmets. Mr. Bell asked about getting a yellow line down the center of Harding Avenue. Mr. Morris wants to have it done on Harding and Coe, but it is hard to find someone to do it for a reasonable price.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Larsen said that an Arbor Day proclamation and celebration is necessary to maintain the City's Tree City USA status. He said that Mr. Morris suggested holding it on April 14th at

Olympic Park. Mr. Larsen reminded the Council about City Manager evaluation forms, and said that he would schedule an in-person evaluation at the next Council meeting.

COMMENTS FROM THE COUNCIL

Councilor McSpadden asked about the planning commission meeting regarding the property on Main Street and Page. The Council discussed the potential use of the property. She also asked about the purchase of a new police vehicle. Chief Zumwalt said they would be buying a new Charger, and surplus old vehicles. Chief Zumwalt said that the new officer, Tristan Walker, would be sworn in the next meeting. Mayor McCann said that he will be gone the next Monday through Wednesday.

ADJOURNMENT

With no other business to consider, Mayor Tom McCann adjourned the regular meeting of April 5, 2016 at 7:26 p.m., with the next meeting scheduled for April 19th, 2016.
